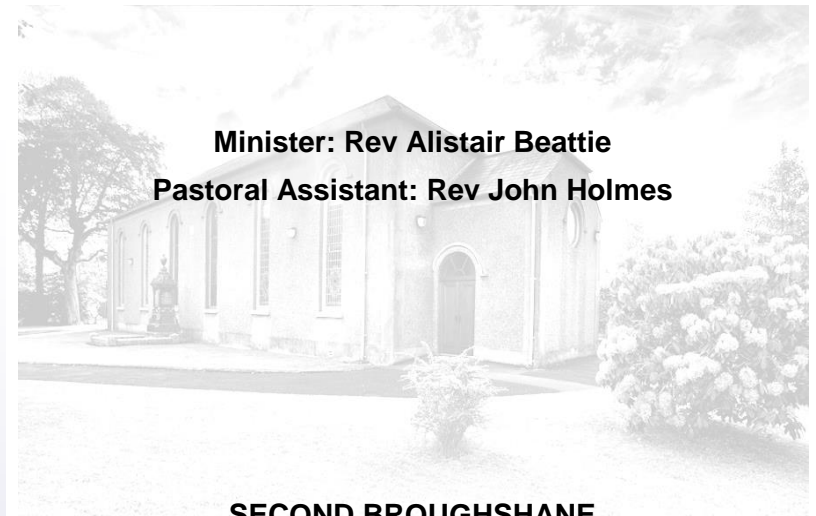


1. **Evening Service in the Church Hall at 6.30pm.**
