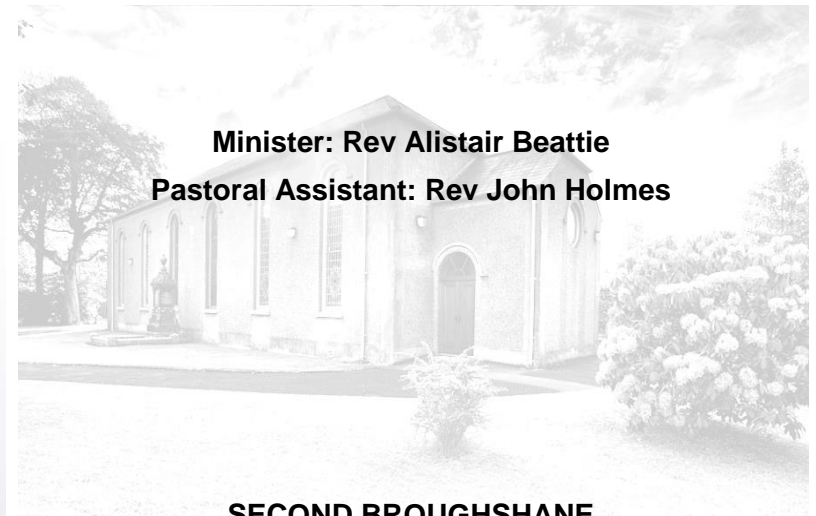


1. **Summer Reports** tonight at 6.30pm in the Church Hall. **Prayer Meeting** at 6pm.
