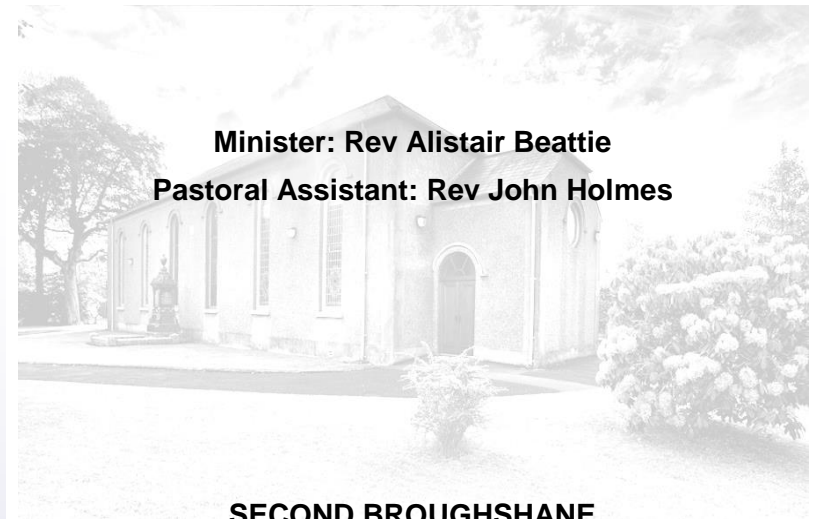


1. **Evening Service** tonight at 6.30pm in the Church Hall. Speaker: Rev Alistair Beattie.
