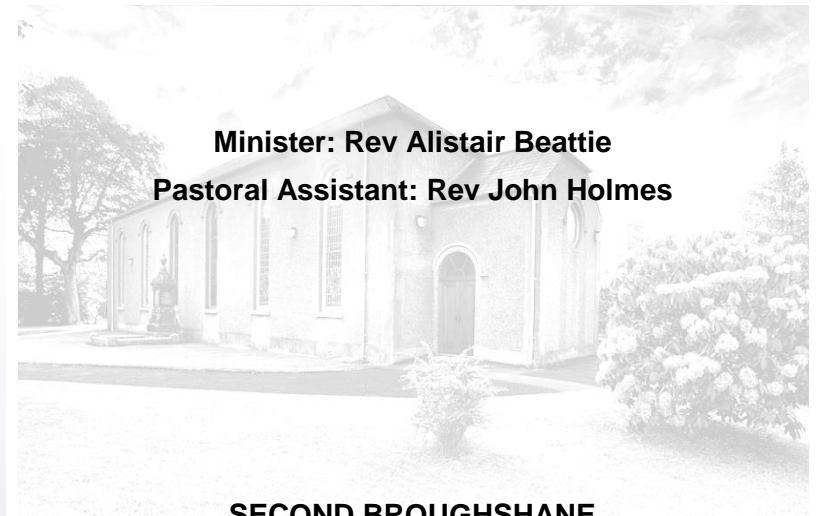
1. **Messy Church** – would all helpers of craft tables be in the hall by 3pm please.
