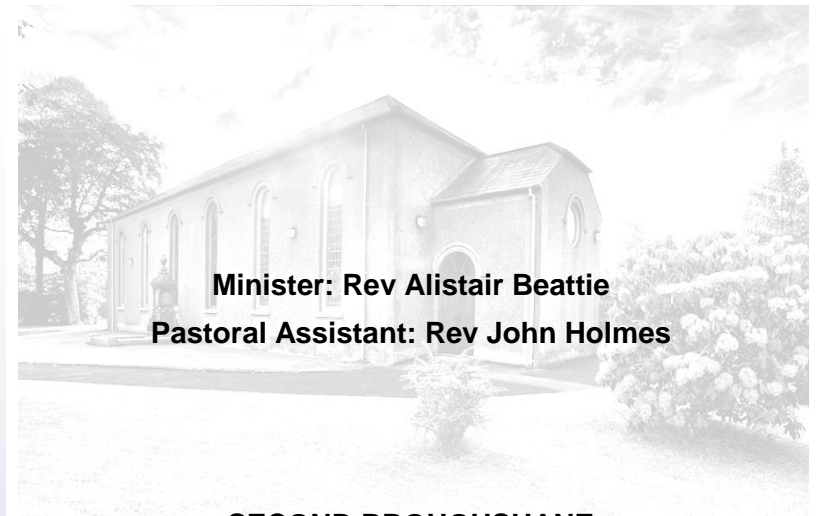


1. **MESSY CHURCH** – all helpers please meet in the Church Hall today at 2.50pm.
