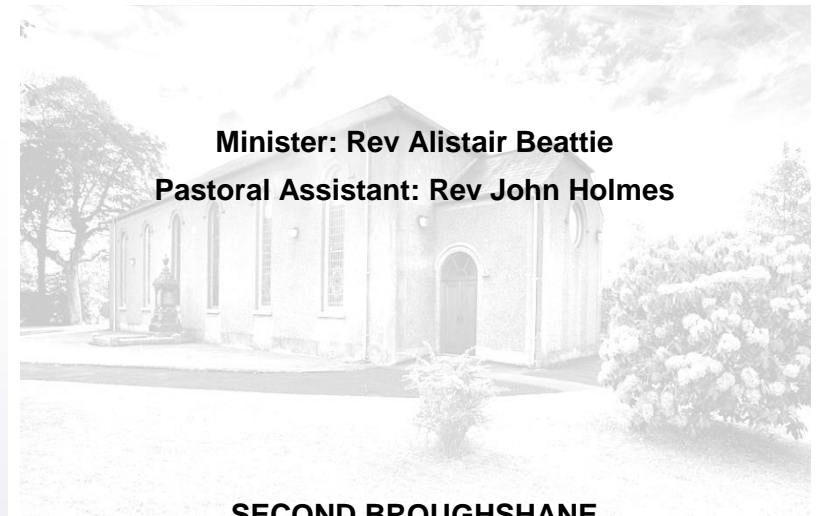


1. **Evening Service** tonight at 6.30pm in the Church Hall. Speaker: Mr Freddie Martin (ASHA).

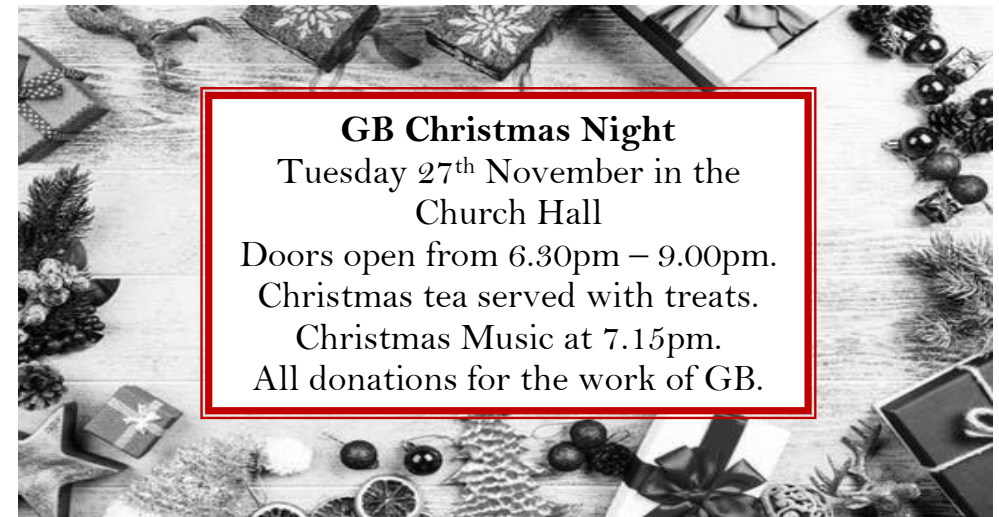
